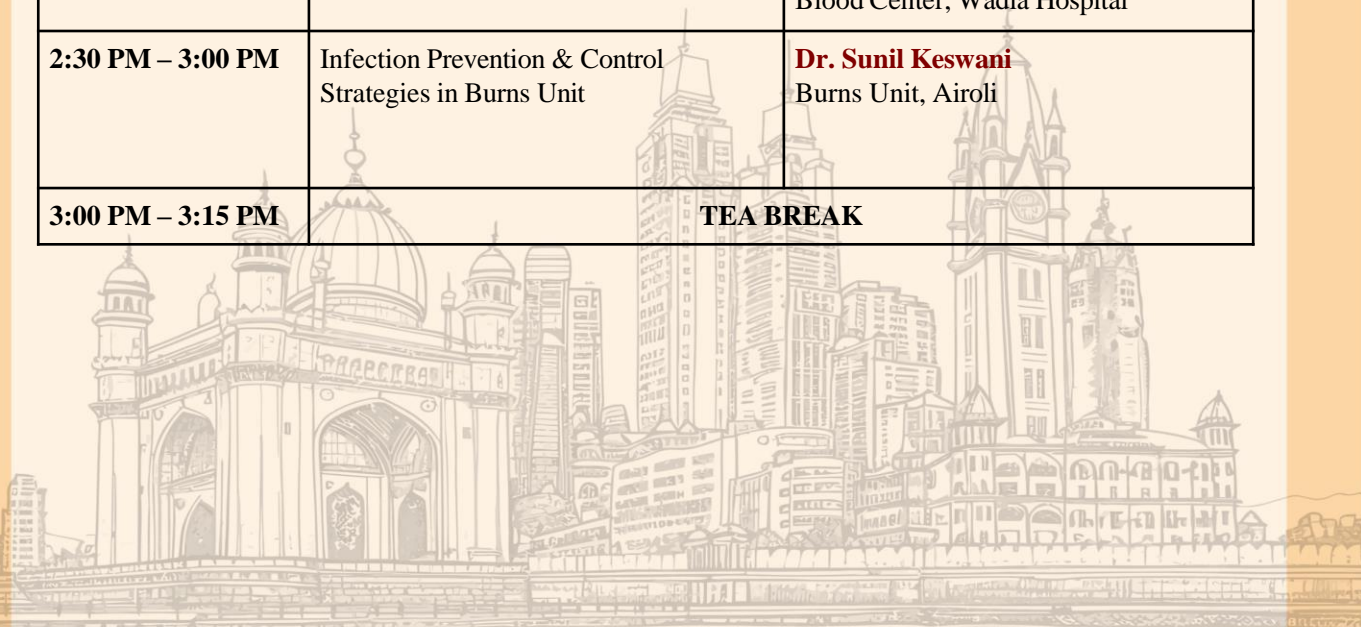

- Followed by authorship and Institutional affiliation.
- Preferred presentation type should be mentioned
 - Oral
 - Poster or either

Abstract Text:

- Abstract should be limited to 250 words and is Exclusive of sub-headings.
- Abstract should clearly state the following:
 - Background and Aims
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusions
- The abstract may include one table.
- Use only standard abbreviations.
- All measurements must be in metric units. An acknowledgement with an identification (unique) number shall be shared with you within one week of receipt of your abstract. Please refer to this abstract number in all correspondence regarding the abstract.
- Do check your spam / junk folder if you do not see an acknowledgement, before contacting us and do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract.
- Presenting authors must be a registered participant.
- All co-authors must be aware of the content of the abstract and agree to its submission.
- All abstracts should be submitted and presented in English with accurate grammar and spelling.
- Abstract submitters should disclose any conflict of interests while submitting the abstract.
